

Breast Cancer Prevention and Care Outreach

Begun in 2003, to address an unmet need in the community, Chambers Health initiated the Women's Health program. Focused on providing a specific set of services and tests for the women of our communities, the program has and continues to grow.

Mammograms –

Most recently, Chambers Health began a partnership with Mammosafe to offer screening mammograms and diagnostic mammograms, and ultrasounds. Mammosafe is a mobile breast imaging center; a luxurious 39 foot coach with separate areas of privacy, lockers, waiting area, private screening and consultation rooms. Mammograms are generally read almost immediately, reducing the anxiety faced by women who sometimes have to wait on results.

Mammograms are offered twice a month through two Chambers Health locations;

Expanded Primary Health Care (E-PHC) –

The E-PHC program is administered by the Division for Family and Community Health Services through the Texas Department of State and Health Services. The primary purpose of the E-PHC program is to provide expanded primary and preventive healthcare services to women, for the early detection of disease. E-PHC services may include; diagnostic laboratory and radiological services, emergency medical services, family planning services, preventive health services (e.g. prenatal medical and dental services, immunizations, appropriate screening for breast and cervical cancer, STD-HIV, cholesterol, hypertension, and diabetes).

The E-PHC program also includes family planning services, breast and cervical cancer screening, and prenatal medical and dental services. *Prenatal medical and dental services are optional and not required.*

The program is geared for women who are 18 years of age or older, are Texas residents, and those who may fall within a 200% Federal Poverty Level or do not qualify for any other publicly-funded program, such as Medicaid.

Outreach and Enrollment –

The Outreach and Enrollment Department at Bayside Clinic and West Chambers Medical Center offers a group of professionally trained and certified staff to provide assistance with the following application processes: Affordable Care Act enrollment through the Health Insurance Marketplace, Medicaid/CHIP, SNAP food stamp, and TANF applications through Your Texas Benefits online.

There may be additional grants or programs to help reduce out-of-pocket expenses for medical care, in addition to prescription assistance.
