Essential Functions:

- Develop and manage a contractual substance abuse program (primarily tobacco and alcohol addictions); manage goals and objectives of program (quality metrics)
- Support Patient Centered Medical Home team-based care to both provide counseling services
- Coordinate specialty care through telehealth
- Strengthen partnerships to better leverage other substance use disorder(s) and mental health related community resources
- Support referrals between clinical partners
- Community outreach to include education to patients, families, and schools on substance use disorder prevention and resources available for those in need
- Become proficient in the Organization's technology platform (eClinicalWorks and MediQuire)
- Manage practice transformation to include professional development and training on various screening tools including SBIRT and IMPACT.
- Conduct individual, couples, group, and crisis counseling relative to social and personal problems, including the development of treatment plans based on clinical experience and knowledge.
- Evaluate patients' physical and mental condition, based on review of client information.
- Coordinates with medical staff on medication management of patients.
- Meet with families, probation officers, Sheriff's Department, Child Protective Services (CPS), or other interested parties to exchange necessary information during the treatment process.
- Familiar with various behavioral health screening tools (i.e. PHQ-9, RCADS, PSC-Y).
- Ability to provide counseling services at the Organization's School-Based Health Center (SBHC) sites on an as needed basis.
